of just stating facts. ^⑥For example, instead of saying, "I had a cold," you can say, "I was

coughing and my nose was running." ^⑦Instead of saying, "It was too hot," you can say,

"The sun burned my skin." ^⑧This way, you can help your friends use their imagination and

come up with their own ideas.

^⑨Second, build tension. ^⑩Good storytellers know how to share information at the right

time. ^⑪You can make your friends curious **by asking questions and delaying the answer.**

^⑫For example, if a character looks nervous, don't say why right away. ^⑬You can show little

signs, like shaky hands or looking at the clock. ^⑭When you finally tell them the reason, it

will surprise them!
