**back of** a big ship. <sup>④</sup>**Even though** it is tiny, it **helps** the ship **turn**. <sup>⑤</sup>How does it **work**? <sup>⑥</sup>First,  
the trim tab moves. <sup>⑦</sup>This **helps** the bigger part, called the rudder, **to turn**. <sup>⑧</sup>Then, the  
whole ship can go in a new direction.
