abstract and complex ideas concrete, simple, and **easier to understand**. <sup>⑦</sup>Pictures also

help them remember more of what they hear. <sup>⑧</sup>Why? <sup>⑨</sup>Because when you see words and

pictures together, your brain remembers them in two ways—with words and with pictures.
