role in baseball. <sup>④</sup>On cold, dry days, the air is thick. <sup>⑤</sup>On hot, humid days, it is thin. <sup>⑥</sup>This  
\_\_\_\_\_

means a baseball travels farther in warm weather. <sup>⑦</sup>When do batters hit the most home  
\_\_\_\_\_

runs? <sup>⑧</sup>It is usually in the summer, especially during the rainy season. <sup>⑨</sup>This is because it

is warmer and more humid then. <sup>⑩</sup>For example, in the MLB season, **the average number**

**of home runs** per game in July is higher than in April. <sup>⑪</sup>Home runs are more common in
