<sup>1</sup>“We are too clean!” says Professor Robin Marks. <sup>2</sup>“That’s why dry skin is so common  
today.” <sup>3</sup>He explains how hot water removes natural oils from our skin: <sup>4</sup>“Think of a  
battered knife under hot water. <sup>5</sup>Hot water melts the oil and **washes it away**. <sup>6</sup>Likewise,  
hot water washes away the natural oil that your body produces to protect your skin. <sup>7</sup>If you  
add soap to hot water, your skin may become too dry and even get damaged. <sup>8</sup>We bathe  
so often that soap is not really necessary.”

<sup>9</sup>Many skin doctors also **advise people not to use** too much soap for different reasons.  
<sup>10</sup>They say that soap can contain harmful chemicals. <sup>11</sup>These can be absorbed through our  
skin and damage our nerves and organs. <sup>12</sup>**The more often** you use strong soap, **the drier**  
**and more sensitive** your skin becomes. <sup>13</sup>In addition, **if overly used**, soap might remove  
beneficial bacteria living on your skin. <sup>14</sup>Doctors suggest that, if you must shower every  
day, you should take a warm shower without soap.
